

10 Promises from **God** Every Christian Should Claim

Sometimes life gets tough. It gets really tough. And it's in those tough seasons that we need some truth to hold on to. Here are 10 promises straight from God Himself that EVERY Christian should claim!

1 **Promise of Blessing**

God wants to bless your life in so many ways. The promise to a *blessed* life is found again and again in the Scriptures. Psalm 1:1-3 says,

Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers, but whose delight is in the law of the Lord, and who meditates on his law day and night. That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither—whatever they do prospers.

2 **Promise of Peace**

When life feels overwhelming, God promises to grant you His peace. Isaiah 26:3 says,

You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you.

3 **Promise of Forgiveness**

Do you feel that you may have gone too far and that God cannot forgive you? In that moment, remember to claim God's promise of forgiveness. 1 John 1:9 says,

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness

4 **Promise of Reaping and Sowing**

Do you ever feel like God has forgotten about all the good that you do? Do you feel like God hasn't acknowledged your obedience and service to Him? God promises in Galatians 6:7-10,

Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life. Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers.

Promise of Intimacy

Do you feel distant and disconnected from God? It's because you moved, not Him. He promises to meet you if you draw near to Him. James 4:8 says,

Come near to God and he will come near to you

Promise of Justice

Do you feel at times that people are mistreating you and getting away with it seemingly with no consequence? Does it seem like injustices in the world go unpunished? God's promise to you in Romans 12:19 says,

Do not take revenge, my dear friends, but leave room for God's wrath, For it is written: "It is mine to avenge; I will repay," says the Lord.

Do you feel at times that you are inadequate and you don't have what it takes to complete God's assignment on your life? Do you feel too weak often times? God's promise to strengthen you with His grace is found in 2 Cor. 12:9 which says,

But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness."

Do you ever question whether God will provide for all of your needs? His promise to provide is found in 2 Cor. 9:8 which says,

And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work

Promise of Providence

Did you know that God can recycle every event in your life for your good and His glory? He promises that He is in complete control in Rom. 8:28 which says,

And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

Promise of Presence

Do you feel alone at times? Do you feel like no one understands what you're going through? Do you feel at times that even God has abandoned you? He promises His presence in Isaiah 43:1-2 which says,

But now, this is what the Lord says—he who created you, Jacob, he who formed you, Israel: "Do not fear, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze.
